In Sri Lanka there is a Christian printing shop, where we most likely will work in (details are not worked out yet). This will make it easier to get a Visa to be able to live there, to learn the language, and to do outreaches.

After Daniel's graduation (09-23-2006) we will stay here on campus until December 14th. During this time Daniel will do a practicum in a printing shop (Bethany Press International), to get learn about the process of printing.

We are planning on being in Germany for about a year, before we will head over to Sri Lanka. During this time we are planning to build up a prayer and finance support group.
